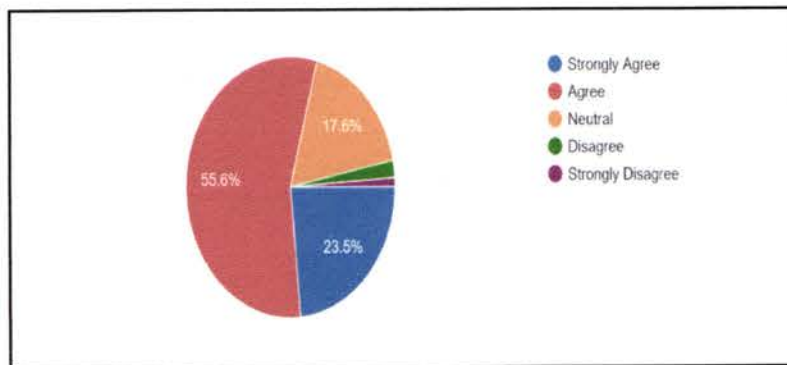




Evaluation of Feedback from Alumni (2020 - 21)

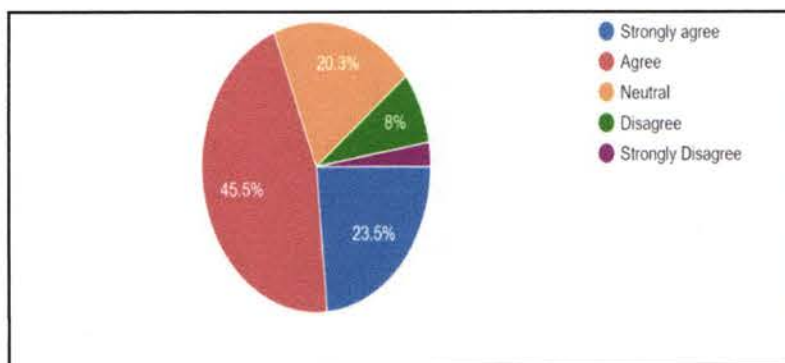
1. The curriculum and syllabus content were appropriate for higher education and/or employment

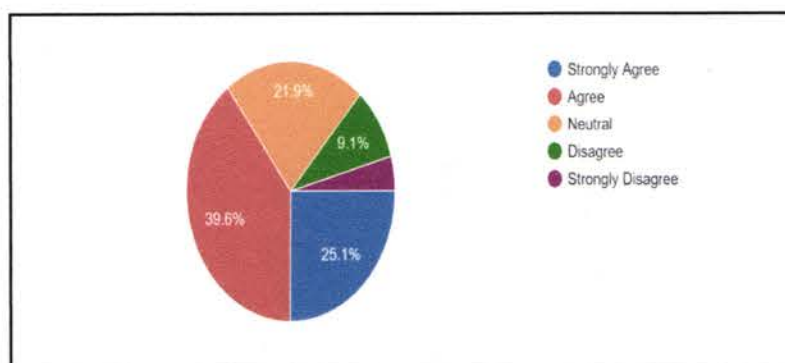
2. Sufficient number of co-curriculum activities were arranged during the study period

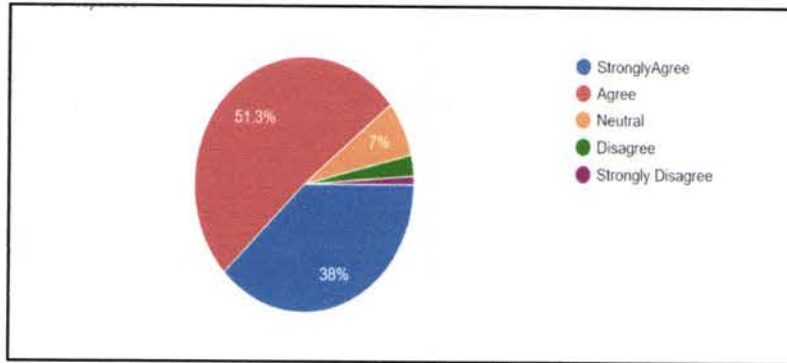
3. The institute/faculty helped student in placement/higher education

- There will be special drive for employment by arranging job fare twice in a year by the Career Counselling Cell of the college.

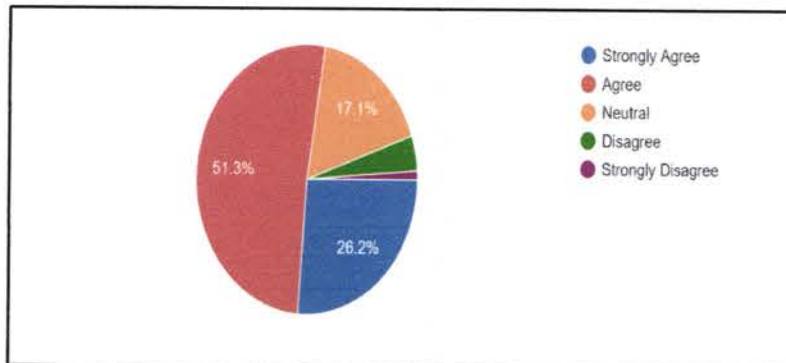
4. The institute offered a good learning ambience

- The institution already has a very good learning ambience but steps shall be taken to improve it further in consultation with the Governing body of the college together with the Heads of the Departments.

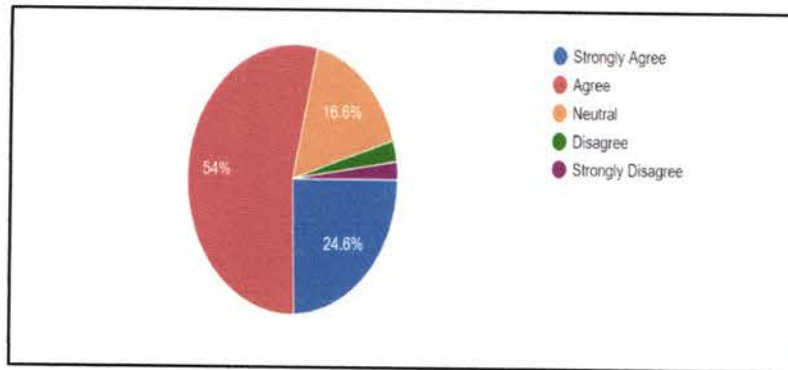
5. The curriculum offers courses with practical and hands on learning experience

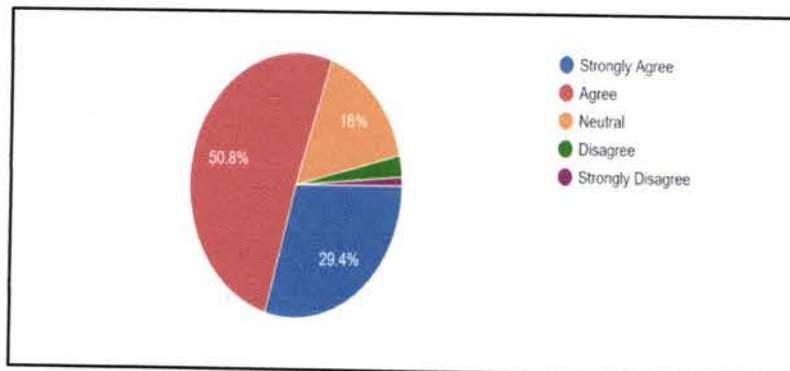
6. All the academic processes of the institute were transparent

- To further improve the transparency of the academic processes the institute proposes to inform the performance of its students in academic sphere to their parents either through SMS or email id.

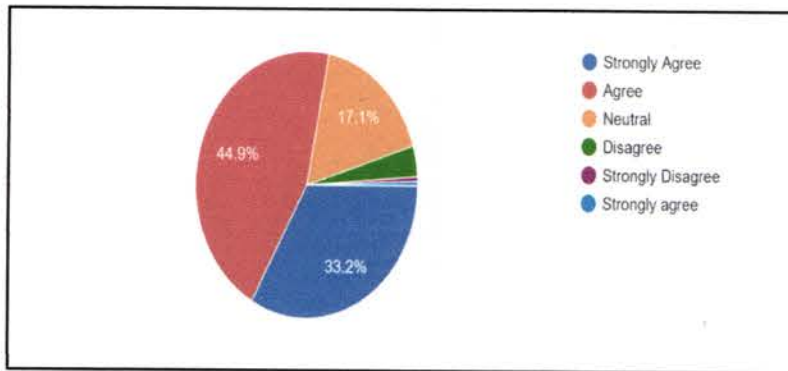
7. The institute is student-centric in all its academic initiatives

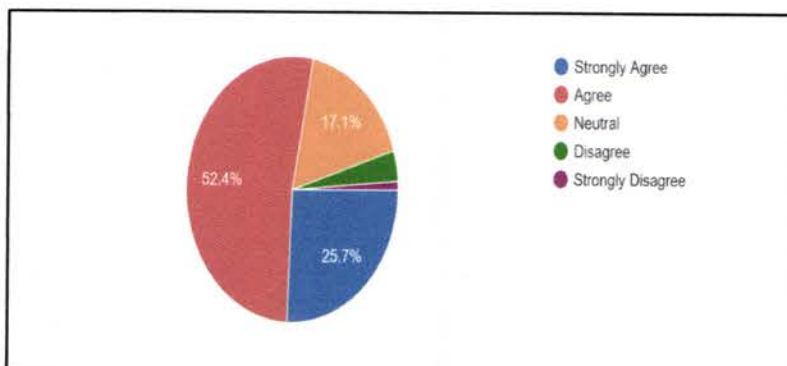
8. The standard of teaching is very high

- The parents shall be informed about the progress of the student.

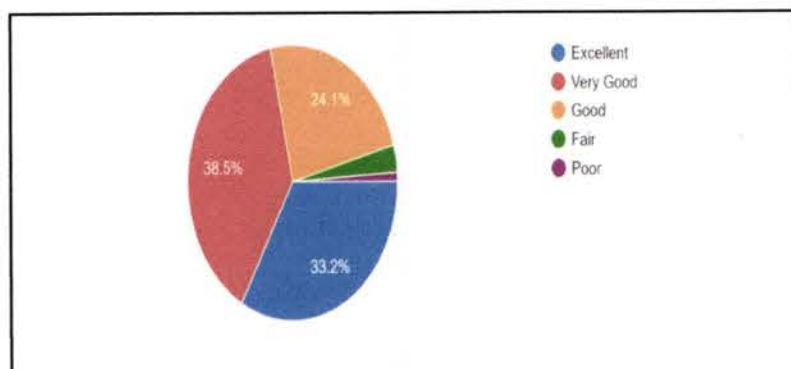
9. Public perception about the institution is very good
