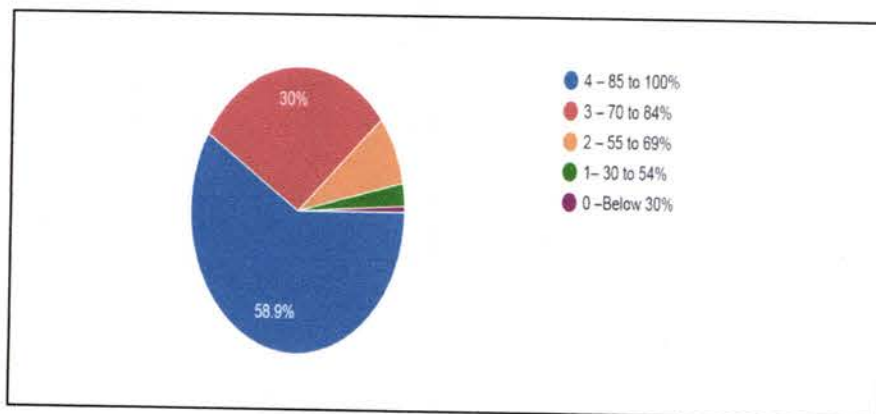




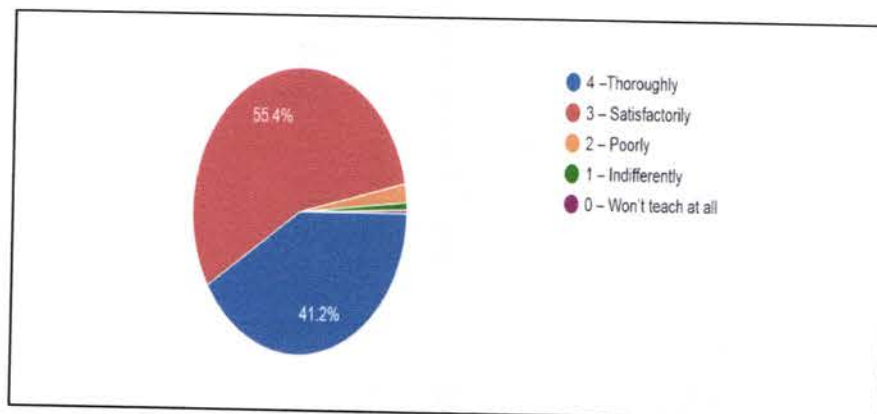
## Student Satisfaction Survey (2020 - 21)

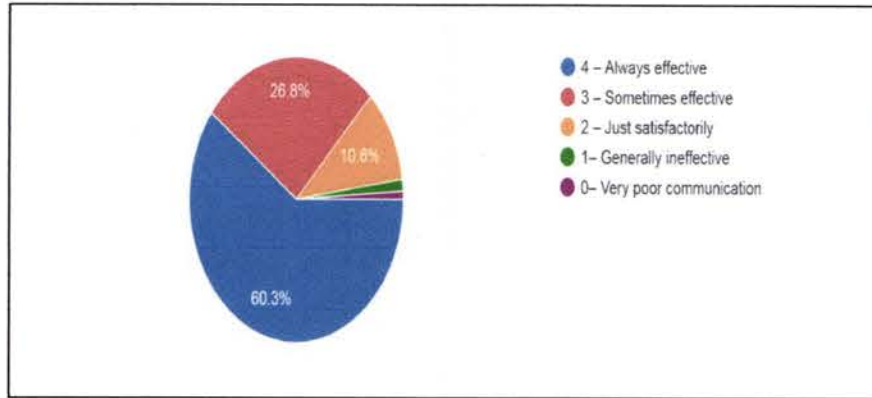

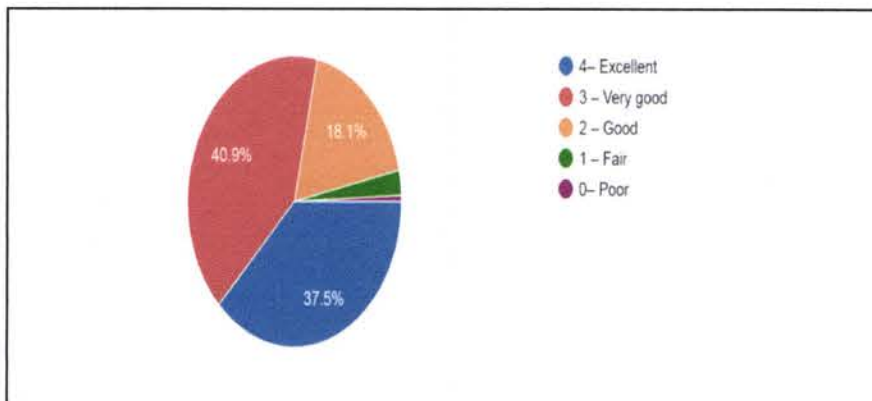
### 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes ?



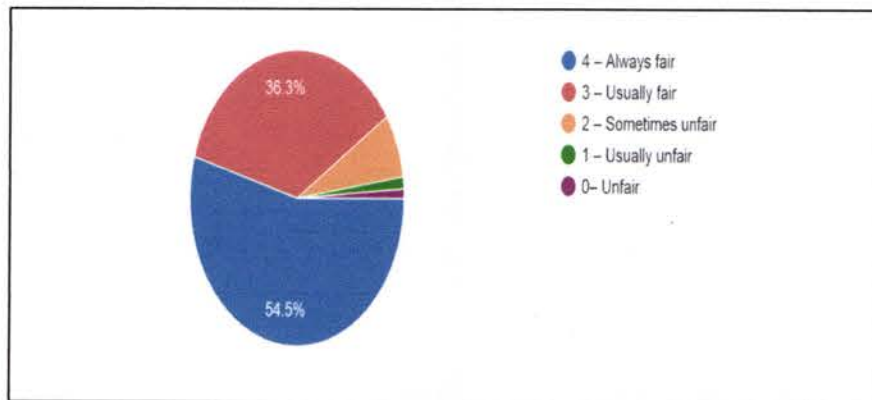

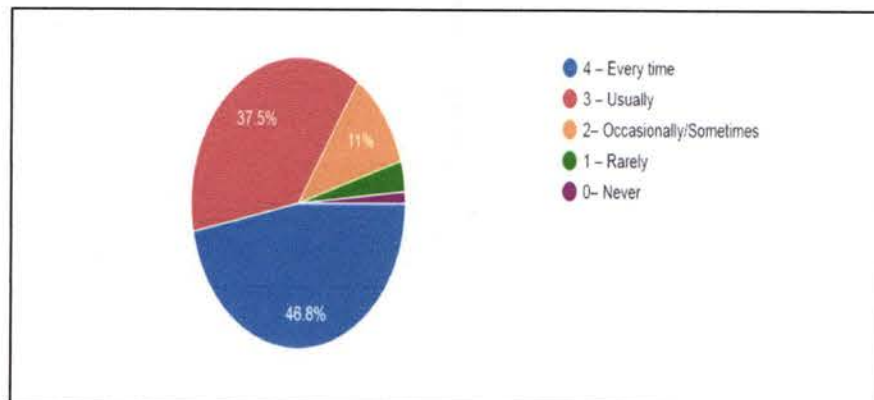
**8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth**



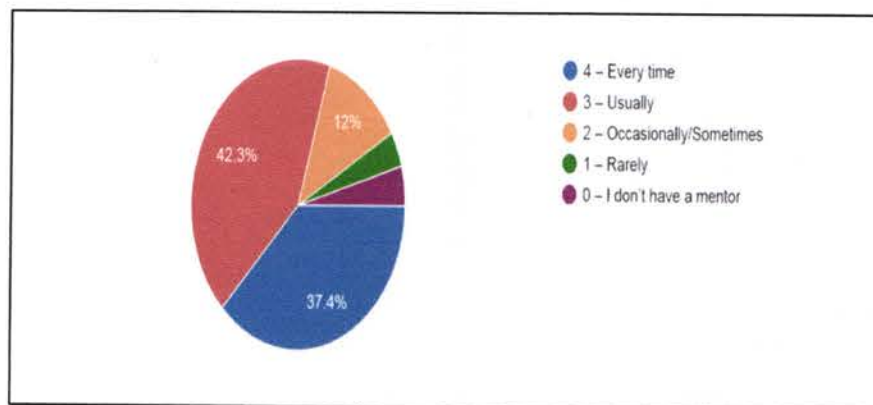

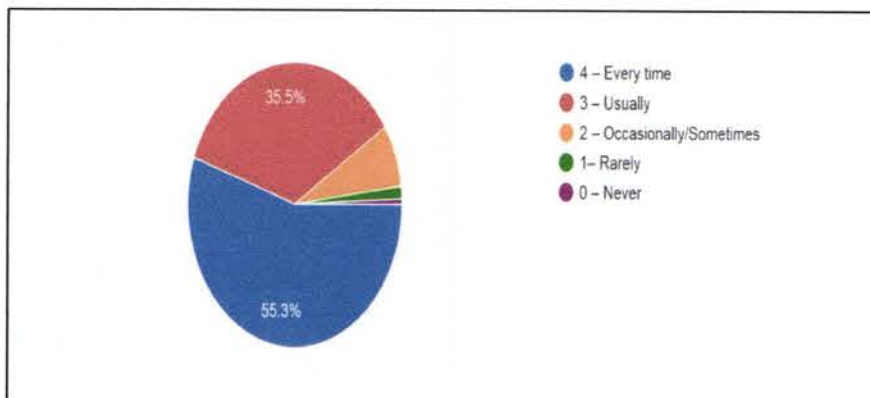

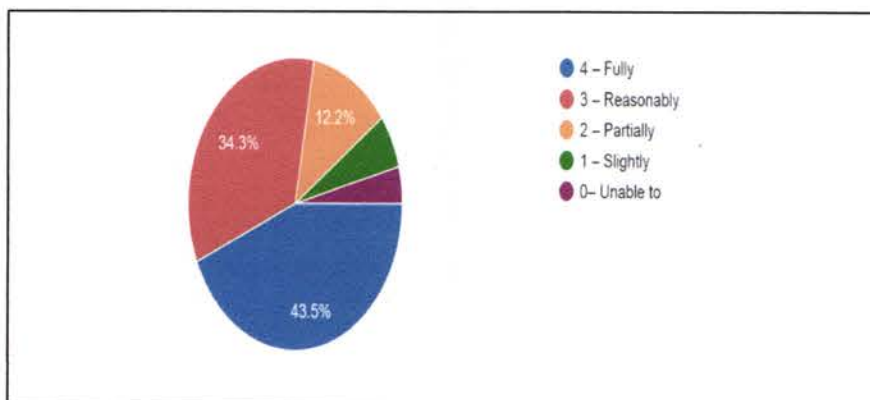

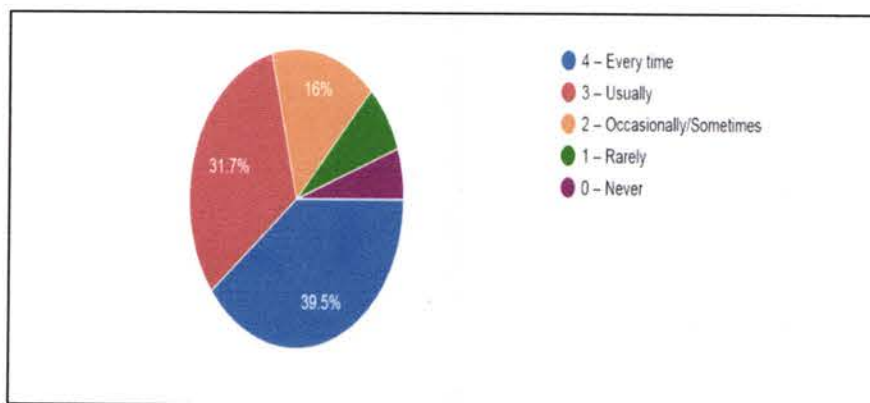

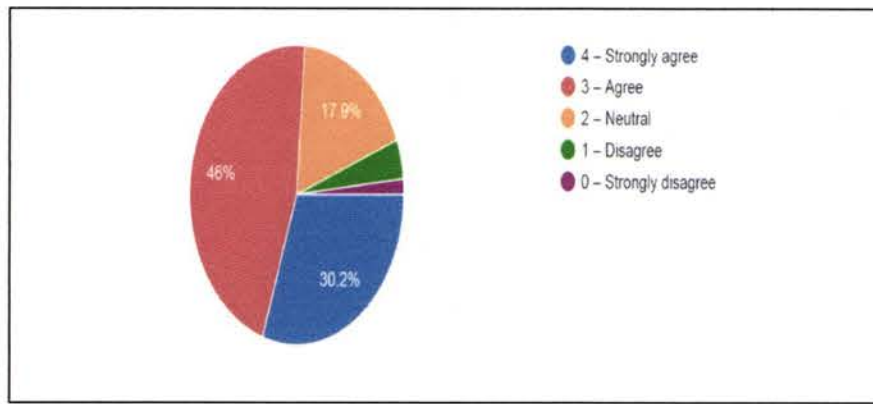

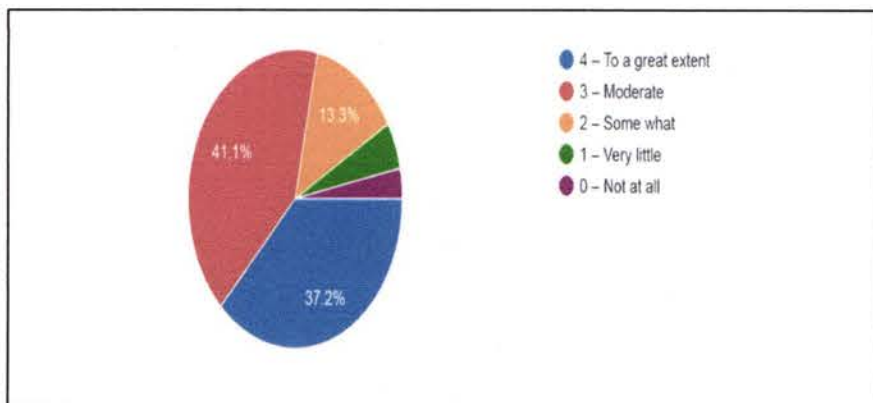

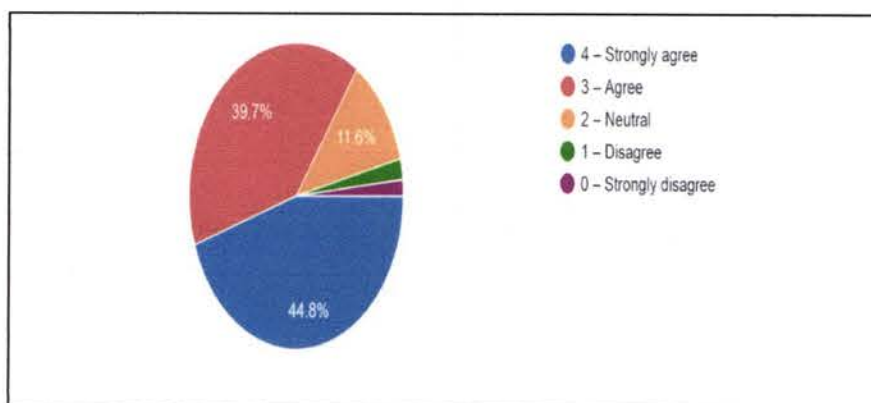

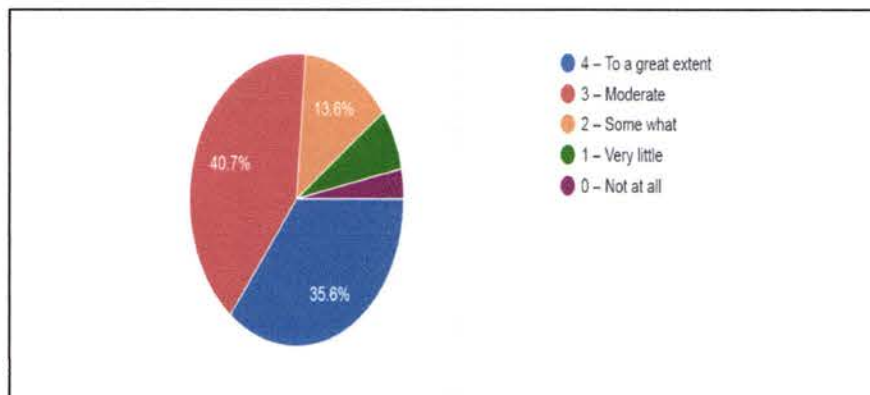

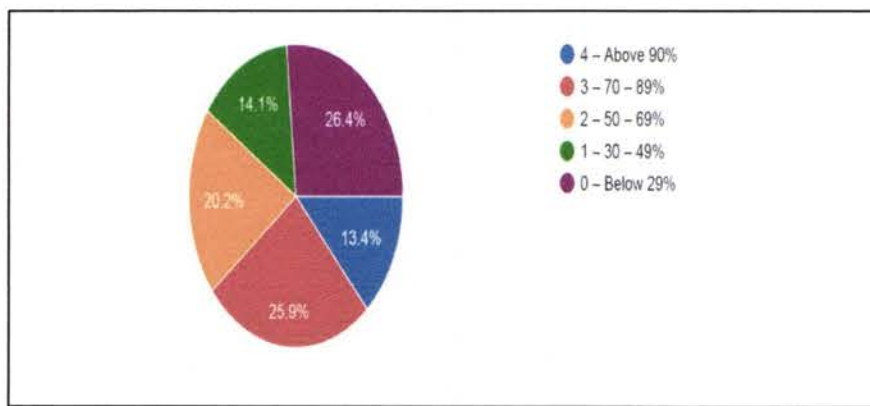

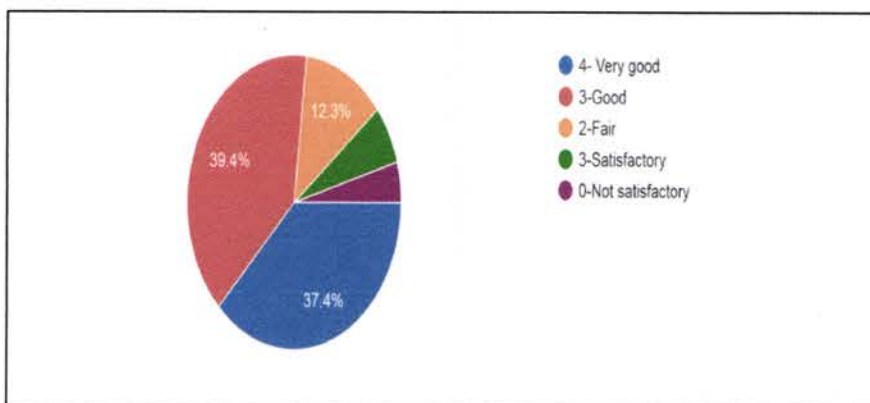

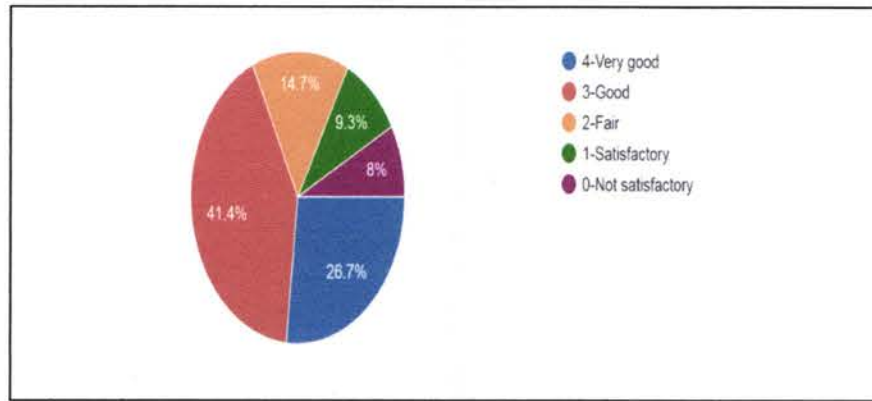
**19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc while teaching**



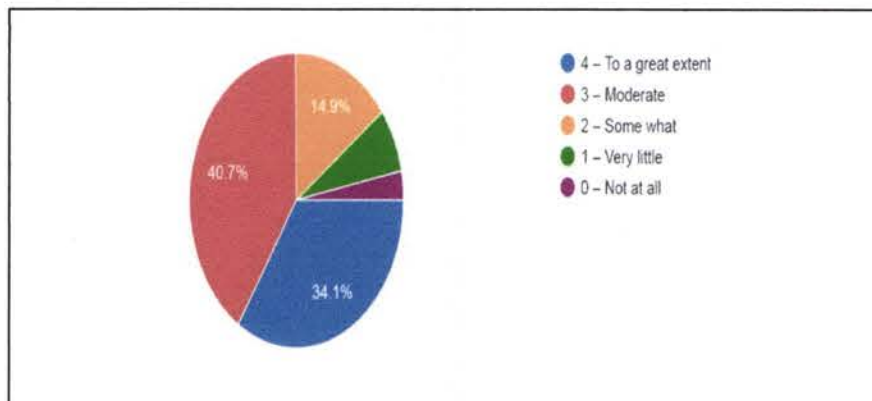

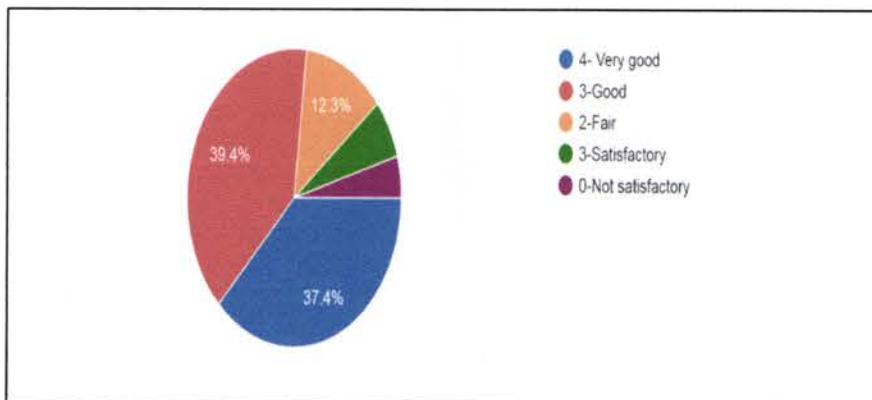
**21. Quality of classroom facilities (Seating arrangement, teaching aids, audio-visual aids etc.)**

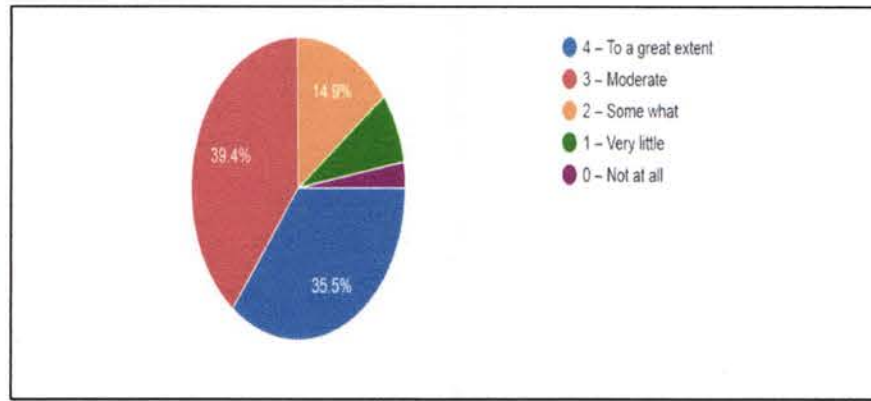

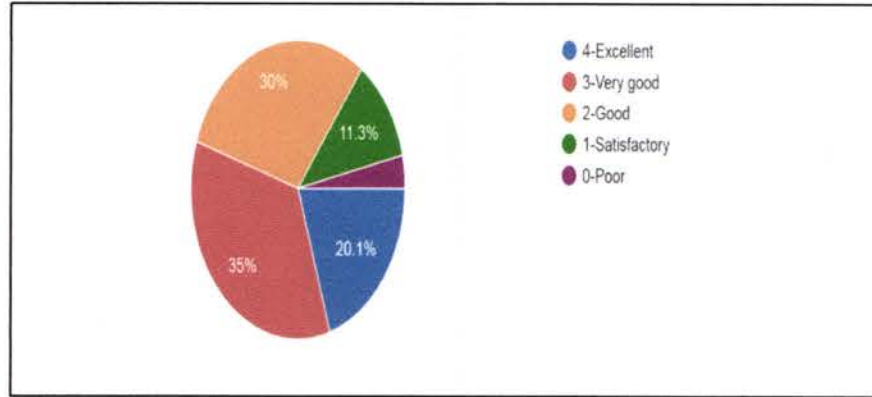

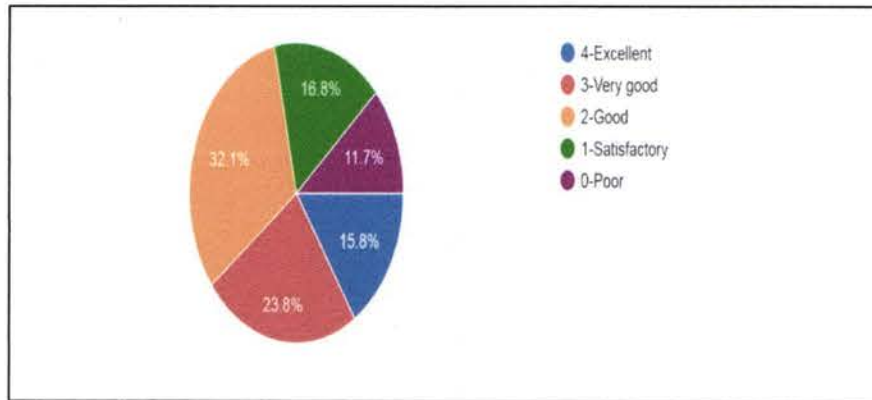
**26. The overall quality of teaching – learning process in your institute is very good**



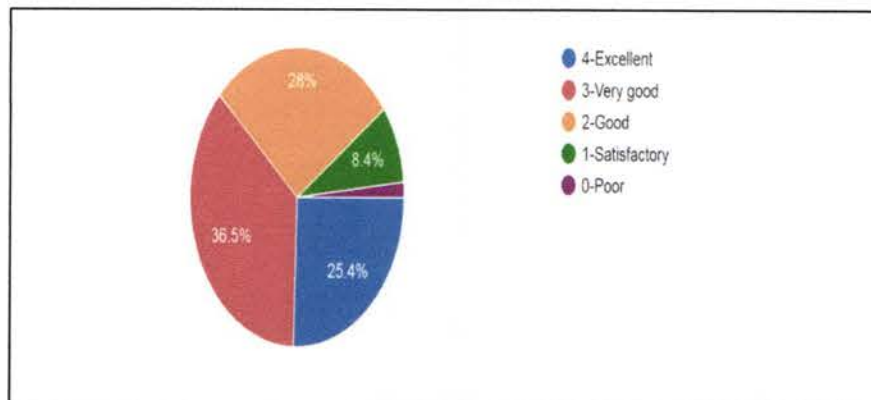
**27. Overall Quality of infra – structural facility**

**30. Some suggestions given by the students to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in the institution :**

- Make teaching a two way interaction.
- Make more Use of ICT tools
- A particular class should be allotted to the Honours Students of every department for their honours classes.
- Apart from girls and boys common room, the college can provide seating arrangements inside the college campus.
- It becomes very difficult for us to understand what the teacher is saying when classes are being allotted in big Halls and Auditoriums, it'd be helpful if the college provides microphone facilities.
- The girl's toilet can be made much better
- More dustbins should be allotted
- I think teacher can use multi language like Hindi, English and Assamese
- Usage of electricity generator as soon as there's a power cut
- Teachers should take class test one time in a week.
- They should teach us topics through examples
- I expect some teachers to stop reading out lines from books and explaining, they should improve their connectivity with students more practically. Teachers should introduce us to different scopes of the subject and where to pursue, where to study further according to our vision, rather just letting us know that it has scope. I expect teachers to be more conscious towards students future rather just completing course and relaxing.
- The laboratories should be more enhanced in every aspect like infrastructure, instruments etc. More projectors and LCD screens should be installed. Co-curricular activities should be more publicised.

- Focus on quizzes and debate shows and clean & tidy of classroom.
- Classrooms must be noise free, Take presentations from students.
- There are many students in our college who are not in a good financial position, so it is necessary to reduce the price of canteen food.
- Learning materials for various entrance exams should be provided to the students.
- Laboratory facilities , increase no,of computers for practical.
- Teachers Must try to find out the weakness and strength in a student, create more friendly environment and to provide more individual support
- Proper notification should be given so that any event is not missed.
- The college library has many drawbacks. Like, the doors of the library are always open, so the noises coming from outside violates the inner environment of the library. So it will be really great to make the library sound proof. Installation of glass door and window in place of that of the wooden ones should be the first step I guess.
