

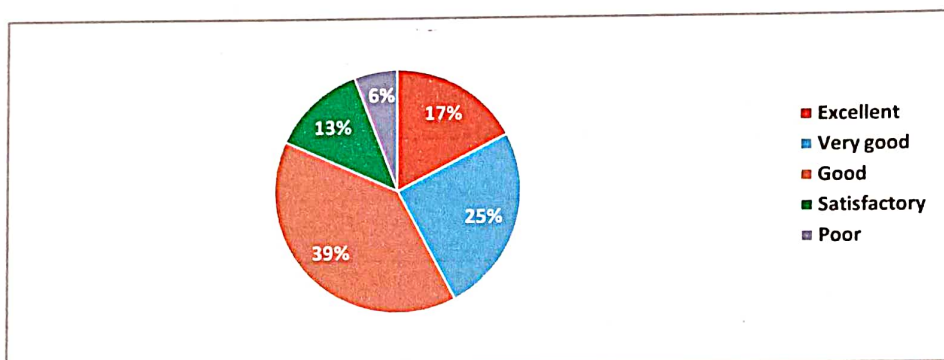


Evaluation of Feedback from Parents (2021 - 22)

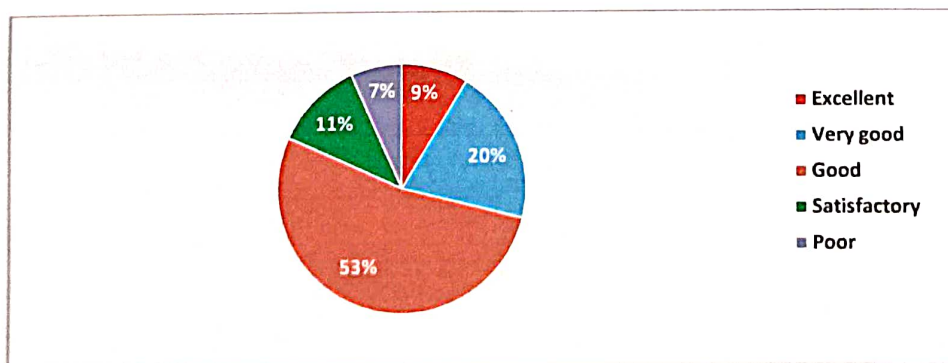

1. To what extent the following facilities of the college satisfy you?

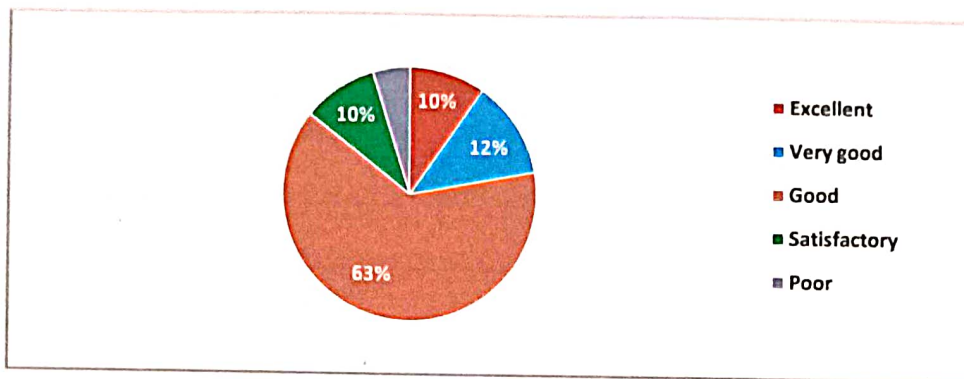

Action taken:

- Extra-curricular activities: The college authority encourages the students to participate in extra-curricular activities. The students who excel in such activities are appreciated in open forum. The students are also encouraged to participate in youth festivals and such other activities. Special incentives are given to the participants. This has improved the students participation in extra-curricular activities.
- Medical: The facilities for students in the existing primary health centre of the college is increased in consultation with the medical officer.
- Hostel: The hostels are refurbished . A new hostel for girls is under construction.
- Library: The library is completely digitized. There is a web portal for thee library.
- Counselling and Guidance: The college has introduced 24 x 7 helpline number.
- Canteen: The canteen committee is assigned duty to review the quality, variety and prices of items sold in the college canteen.
- Internet facilities: This facility is further revamped with an aim to make the entire college campus a wi-fi zone. At present the internet speed is more than 100 Mbps.

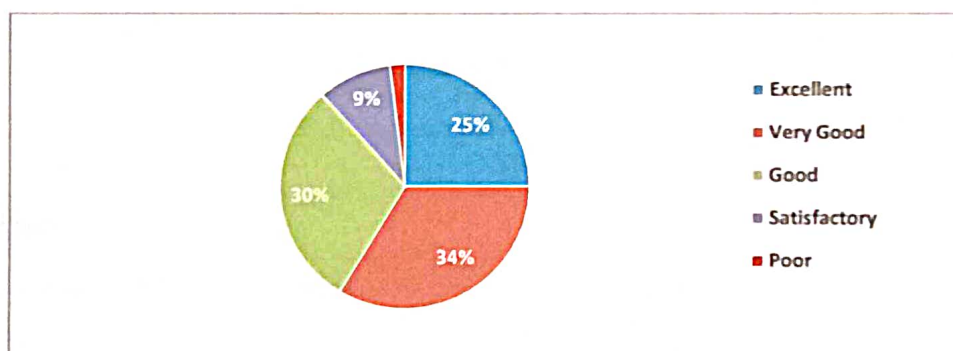
2. How is the reputation of the College ?

- The college shall take up all the measures and will also hold a meeting with all the stakeholders to discuss about the various ways to further improve its reputation.

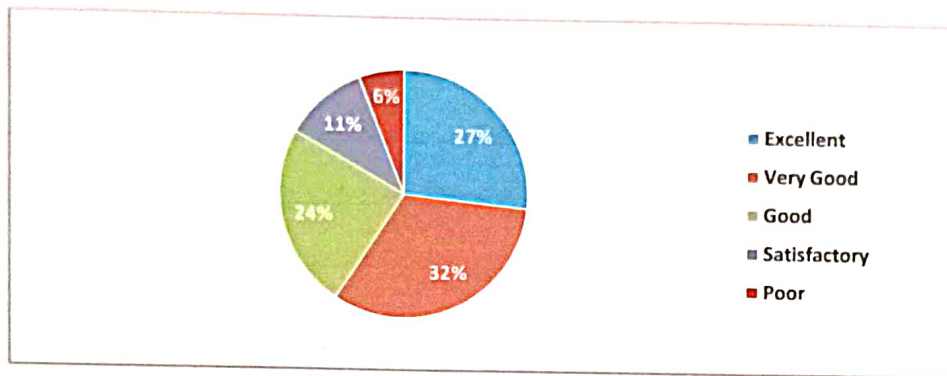
3. How would you rate the infrastructure and lab facility of the college?

- The college has submitted a proposal to NEC to further augment its infra-structure.
- The college also plans to construct an administrative block from its own resources

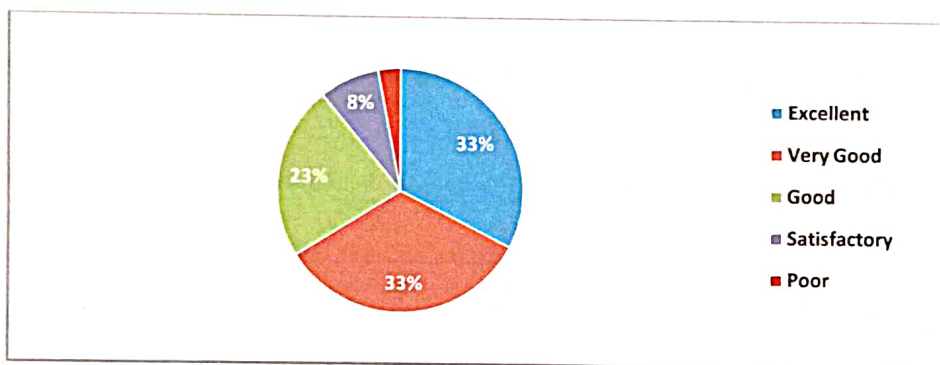
4. How is environment and ambience of the College ?

The college has constituted various committees through which attempts have been made to further improve the environment and ambience of the college .

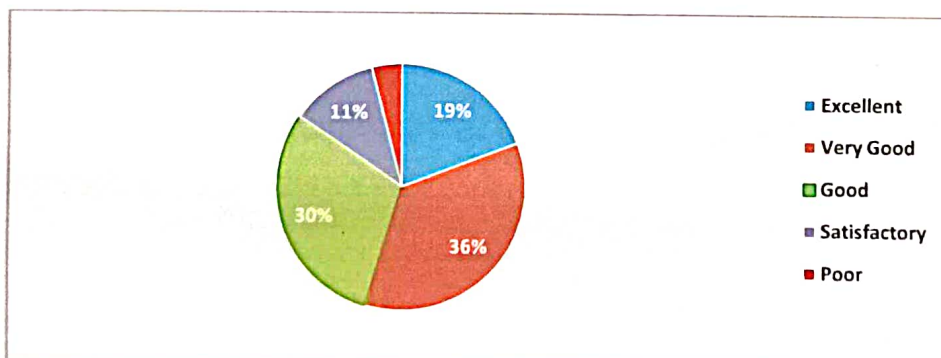
5. How is the reputation of the college?

The college has undertaken several measures to further improve its reputation.

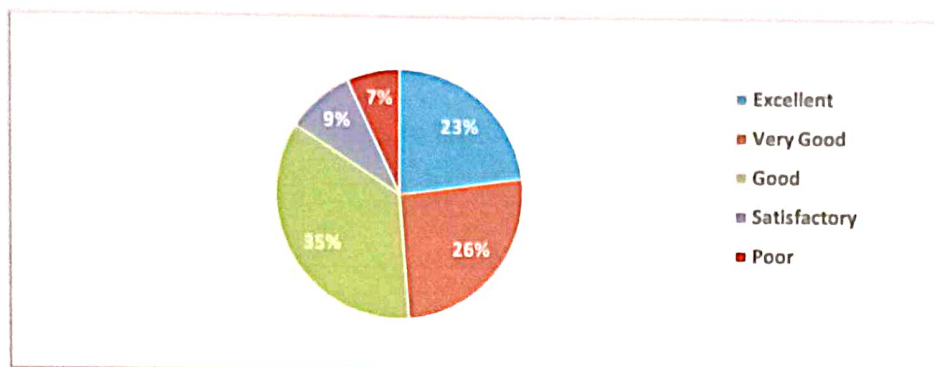
6. What is your assessment of the security arrangements and safety measures in the college?

The college has recruited security personnel from a reputed agency and further increased the number of cc-cameras installed in the campus.

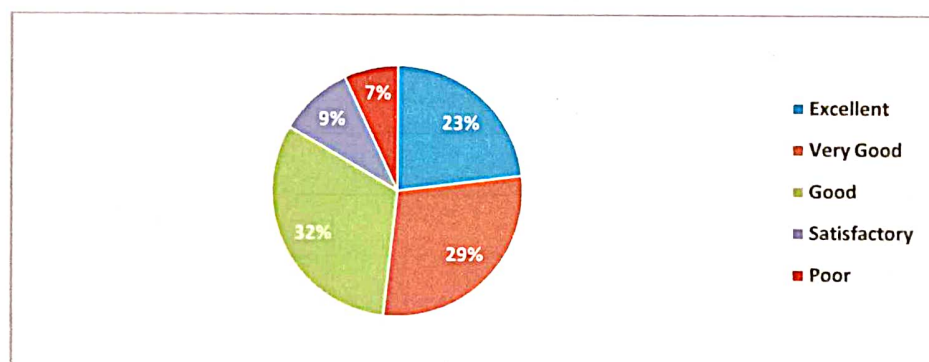
7. How would you rate the admission procedure?

- For the benefit of the students, the number of helpline numbers are increased.

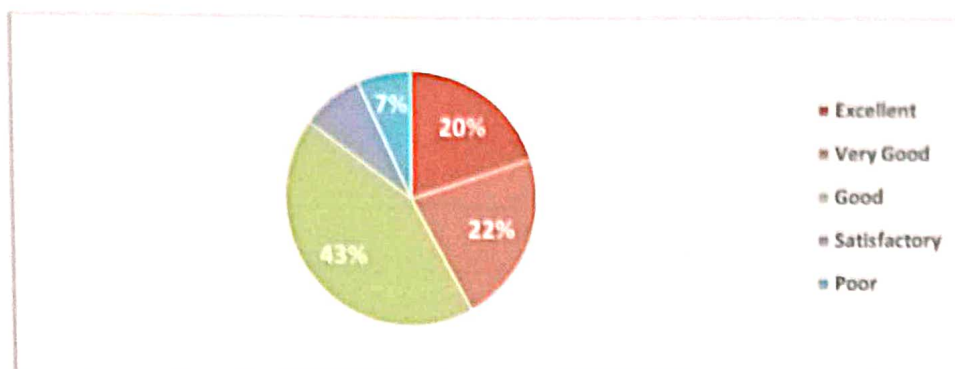
8. How would you rate the academic discipline (i.e. timely conduct of lectures, practical etc.) observed by the college?

- The HoDs are requested to submit monthly class taken report to the Office of the Principal regularly.

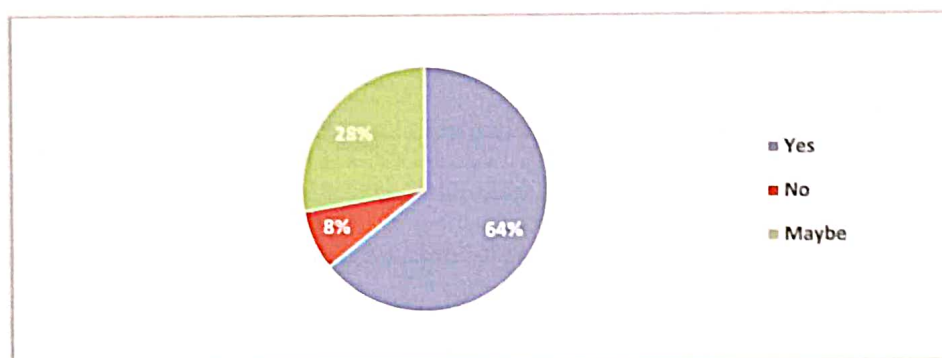
9. How would you rate the use of information and communication technology by the college?

- There is also a proposal to set up a teaching learning centre under PMMMNMTSS


10. Have you observed any improvement in soft skills, knowledge ethics, morality in your son/daughter while staying in college?




Action taken:
