

Evaluation of feedback from students (2021 - 22)


Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) is committed to provide the highest standards of educational and other provision for its students, and encourages its students to provide the college with thoughtful and constructive feedback. The feedback from students was taken in online mode by preparing a set of questions in Google Form. Overall response from the students indicated moderate to high level of satisfaction with the quality of teaching, infra-structure and other facilities provided. Following is the report of feedback and action taken by the college: The feedback was taken in a scale of 5 which indicates very good and 1 indicates very poor.

1. Feedback on Courses and Studies:


2. Feedback on the Principal:




ACTION TAKEN: Based on the above feedback, initiatives shall be taken to improve it further.

3. Feedback on the office:


Efficiency in doing the allotted job:




Attitude of prompt response to your need:



Helping attitude:




- The college plans to initiate some training programme in soft skills for the office staff which would help in improving their efficiency.
- The college authority has taken into consideration the opinion of the students given in the feedback and had a discussion with the office staff on how to improve its response to various needs of the students like incorporating a time frame, setting up a students' helpdesk etc.
- It was observed that most of the students feel the overall commitment of the office staff is very good. But there is a scope for further improvement and hence the college authority in its discussion with the office staff recommended them to enhance their overall commitment further.

4. Feedback on library:




- The collection of text books, reference books, magazines etc of the library shall be enhanced further.
- Recently the College library has been made accessible through OPAC (On Line Public Access Catalogue). The library plans to augment further the number of its e-journals and e-books.
- The College is also registered under N-LIST programme under UGC-Infonet Digital Library Consortium and also has plans to register in more such platforms.

5. Feedback on accessory facilities:



- The speed of internet connection has been revamped to 300 MBPS. The process of converting the entire college campus into wifi zone is being carried out.
- There is a plan to buy more photostat machines and the students shall be offered the facility in a subsidised rate.
- The canteen committee is assigned duty to review the quality, variety and prices
 of items sold in the college canteen. Moreover recently the vendor to run the
 canteen has been changed.
- The college already has a computer cell with a good number of computers and the process of opening several courses like PGDCA etc is going on. There are computer laboratories in some departments also.


6. Feedback on college hostels:



- A new hostel for girls is under construction which would mitigate the problem of accommodation of girl students of the college.
- The college also plans to construct another hostel for the boys in the near future.
- There is a hostel committee to look after the hygiene, food quality etc of the hostel.
- The college authorities plans to introduce more indoor games for the hostel inmates and also to develop a cricket and football ground.
- The hostel superintendent with the help of hostel monitors shall try to improve the discipline amongst the inmates further.
- The hostel attendants are requested to improve their feedback further.

7. Feedback on departmental laboratories:

(Only for science students with practical course)



- All HOD's will review the functioning of the laboratories regularly.
- A training programme on laboratory management for laboratory bearers has already been organised and more such programmes shall be organised in the near future.
- The college has received grants from RUSA and DBT under "star college scheme" for laboratory development under which a sizeable number of laboratory equipments have been purchased together with upgradation of laboratory infra-structure.

Different suggestions given by the students: 8.

- To organise regular workshops on various topics for students
- To construct a large gymnasium and other sporting facility
- The hygiene of the toilets/washrooms needs to be maintained and need to construct more washrooms for students.
- Need for more ICT enabled classroom.
- More parking space for students' vehicles (bikes and scooties)
- More water filters are required.
- Request to provide contemporary/latest fictional and self motivating novels in the library to be up-to-date with the current writing style.
- Request to be more vigilant and strict monitoring regarding the ban on use of gutkha and pan masala in the college campus.
- Need of a large canteen and more small cafetarias within the campus.
- Need of a big boys' common room.
- The library is not sound proof.
- Need for a large digital notice board.
- More generators are needed for power back up.

More effective student counselling cell is needed.
