Activity Title: Awareness Programme on Promoting Human Values

Abstract/Summary of the activity program: The Anti-Ragging cell, Arya Vidyapeeth College (Autonomous) organised an Awareness Programme on Promoting Human Values on 26-04-2023 at Boy's Hostel premise at 3.30pm in presence of sixty students. DR, Gitanjali Hazarika, Associate Professor, Dept. of Assamese, AVC was invited as the resource person. The programme started with the welcome speech by Dr. Dalimi Devi.. The resource person deliberated upon the relevance of promoting human values in the context of complete annihilation of the evil practice of ragging. As ragging is a sociological and psychological problem, in India it is a punishable offence Under IPC 116. The minimum punishment for ragging is either cancellation of admission or suspension from attending classes and the punishment may extend to 3 years of jail, Rs. 10,000/- fine or both. The speaker helped the students to understand the legal and moral implications of the practice of ragging as it is a non-bail able offence. Cases may be lodged in under many sections of IPC according to the damages faced by the victim. So, only the promotion of mutual trust and fellow-feeling can help to create a hospitable environment in hostels and campuses to enhance the quality of life lived and avert ragging altogether and the participants thoroughly enjoyed the awareness programme. Dr. Ranju Medhi, Convenor of the Cell offered the vote of thanks and the programme was successful.
