Abstract / Summery of the activity program: --

The external members along with all faculty members discussed in detail about the criteria to make a remarkably good syllabus for the benefits of future geology students. In the meeting

The members approved the modified basic syllabi for the four year NEP – UG- Geology course.

Detail syllabi for Sem. I & II including the SEC finalized after necessary inputs from the BoS members. The external members suggested exploring collaboration through MoU with industries and knowledge institutions like GSI, OIL, NESAC, Hydrocarbon & Hydropower industries etc., to stimulate research and to facilitate internship for geology students. Another output of the meeting was that the student internship programmes may be assigned 4 credits for a minimum of eight-week actual work including both field and lab components. The extra 2 credit might be allowed as a free credit which could be utilized by the student at the later period as a part of the course. As geology is a field based subject, the field work of minimum 7 -10 days' duration may be carried out for 1 credit.
